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General Comments
Joshuas Room QAM observed children actively engaged in their learning environment. Children were throwing balls, dancing to music, and exploring various areas of the room. Educators reported current interests including trucks, sensory toys, and dancing. The environment included slides, dramatic play, literacy materials, art activities, and a variety of toys. Educators remained engaged and responsive to the children throughout the observation. Grandpas Room Educators shared that children have been interested in water play, music, dancing, and singing. Children had just transitioned indoors from outside and were seeking comfort and connection from their educator, who provided hugs and reassurance. Another educator was appropriately rotating through diaper-changing duties, maintaining supervision and routine care. Margarets Room Children were preparing for their upcoming graduation. They were trying on gowns and hats, and some were having their photos taken. Educators demonstrated positive child guidance and supportive direction as children participated in these activities. Hannahs Room Children's interests included large Lego, water play, and color-based activities. QAM observed children building with Lego, playing with dinosaurs, and dancing to music. QAM also reminded the educator about ensuring toxic products remain securely locked and out of children's reach, and the educator acknowledged the reminder. Jack's Room Educators reported children's interests as playing with paper swords, cars, and baby dolls. QAM observed children outdoors engaging in sand play and exploring musical instruments such as bells.
