In the outside play area, there is a wide variety of age-appropriate materials for the children to interact and engage with: sleds, bikes, playhouse, loose parts, bowls, diggers, foam blocks and more. It was also observed a music wall in the outside play area.

It was observed in the inside play area a wide variety of materials as well. The art shelf is stocked with different medium for creating art, books are set up throughout the room as well as the book center, webs were observed

on the wall of the children's interests. Children's art is displayed on the walls.

It was also observed that each child has a portfolio of their learning and art.

Handwashing was observed occurring throughout the morning, snack was also observed where the Educator had a child pick a book which she read to the children during snack time.

Positive interactions as well as positive child guidance techniques were also observed during the renewal inspection. Inspector and Quality Assurance Monitor observed Educators down at the level of the child(ren), speaking kindly and redirecting behaviors appropriately.
