General Comments
<p>A renewal inspection occurred today.</p> <p>The children were observed going for a walk to explore the neighborhood. Educators indicated the children went to the Public Gardens as well as explored Rockwood Park. The children were also observed during morning snack, inside play, outside play, lunch, nap/quiet time and playing the gym.</p> <p>Room 2, the school-age room, was set up with invitations prior to the arrival of the children. The children's learning: art, science activities are documented and displayed throughout the room. The dramatic play area (kitchen) has real dishes (China cups and saucers, glasses, plates, bowls, etc) for the children to interact and engage with giving them a more authentic kitchen area.</p> <p>In Rooms 3, 4 and 5 the children's current learning and art is displayed for the children to revisit at their leisure. There is a variety of age-appropriate materials in all rooms for the children to interact and engage with. Handwashing was observed occurring numerous times during the inspection.</p> <p>During the inspection, educators were observed having positive interactions with the children in their care and responding and tending to their needs.</p>
