lunch. Those who finished their lunches early, were observed looking at books, playing with cars, and building					
with blocks. QAM observed, while educators prepared the rooms for nap time (6A, 6B, 7A, 7B, & 8A). Nap cots					
were observed to be at least 46 cm away from each other, in each room. Several examples of documentation were observed in each room. Age-appropriate toys and activities were observed in each room. Positive child					
guidance techniques were observed by all educators – educators were observed offering choices, anticipating					
children's needs, understanding child development, and respecting the children's feelings.
