<p>General Comments</p> <p>Room 6A/6B During the morning visit, the QAM observed invitations featuring letters, blocks, and tissue paper to support color recognition and sensory exploration. Children were engaged in various activities, including playing with toy buses and participating in dramatic play with kitchen materials and pretend food. Some children were finishing their snack.</p> <p>Educators were seated with the children, providing support with eating routines and engaging in conversations about the plans for the remainder of the day. The room contained a wide range of materials, offering children multiple choices for play and learning.</p> <p>Room 7A/7B The QAM observed children having snack during the morning visit. The learning environment included invitations with pipe cleaners and Magna-Tiles. Documentation displayed on the walls reflected learning related to letters, storytelling, cardboard exploration, block play, and art experiences.</p> <p>Room 8 This room was observed during circle time. The educator was leading a song with actions, with some children participating while others engaged in different activities around the room. An invitation featuring dinosaurs and eggs in a forest setting was available and was used by children after snack.</p> <p>The educator reported that current child interests include animals, colors, and sensory toys. Outdoors, children were observed enjoying play with cars and bubbles.</p> <p>All child-to-educator ratios and parent boards were correct and up to date.</p>
