General Comments							
Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility to conduct a license renewal inspection on March 16th, 2023.  The senior group of children were just arriving for the day and the junior group of children were playing outdoors when licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility.							
Child-to-staff ratio, on the day of the inspection, was within regulation according to the Early Childhood Services Act. Staff and children files were very organized and complete with all of the required documentation.							
The senior group of children came in the classroom and chose a centre to play at. The junior class was just finishing up their snack when licensing staff began observations in their classroom. After their snack, the junior group of children engaged in play centres.							
The flow in both classrooms were busy but very smooth, even during transitions.							
The educators in both classrooms were engaged with the children at the child's level. The children were free to choose centres and were able to freely move from one centre to another. The classrooms were very clean and had an abundance of play materials for the children to play with.
