<p>General Comments</p> <p>A renewal inspection was conducted today. Children were observed in both the indoor and outdoor environments. The senior group was inspected first, as the junior group was outdoors for after-school play.</p> <p>Educators in the senior group completed attendance, after which children were asked who would like a turn on the computers. Nine children raised their hands and proceeded to use the computers to play educator-approved, age-appropriate games. To ensure fairness, educators have implemented a system using a jar of wooden name sticks to determine computer turns when interest exceeds available spots.</p> <p>Children not using the computers were engaged in various activities, including board games with educators and open-ended art at the tables. A large selection of board games, such as Operation, Chess, Heads Up, and Gravity Maze, was neatly organized on an open shelf. Additional materials available included a bracelet-making kit, LEGO, and clearly labelled bins containing stickers, stencils, and stamps. Educators were actively engaged with the children and were observed interacting at the children's level, promoting positive communication.</p> <p>In the junior room downstairs, a variety of materials were available, including cars and trucks, dolls with clothing, play food for the kitchen area, action figures, and building blocks. Art supplies included paper, markers, pencil crayons, glueable loose parts, glue, tape, and scissors. Children were observed outdoors building snowmen and later returned inside to wash their hands before having their snacks brought from home and open-ended play.</p> <p>Parent information boards were reviewed and complete, containing all required postings such as updated licensing information, monitoring and renewal reports, allergies and fire exit procedures. Fire drill logs were current and complete. Incident reports, staff files, and 15 child files were also reviewed and complete. Licensing had conversation with admin about fire inspection renewal, last inspection was 2024-09-24 and will reach out with any updated information.</p>
