Comments: Quality assurance monitor noticed that the attendance record sheet was not the attendance sheet provided by the minister. Daily attendance records need to be filled upon arrival and departure of the children. Operator must ensure that the attendance record sheet is the document provided by the minister and needs to ensure that they are properly filled. Administrator immediately entered all the attendance on the sheet provided by the minister and will continue to do so from now on. Deficiency is now compliant			
39(2) A licensed facility shall have a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for each of the following: (a) toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies;	39(2)(a)	Apr 18, 2023	Apr 18, 2023
Comments: In the bathroom, the storage space for cleaning supplies was unlocked. Toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies must be locked and inaccessible to children. The administrator immediately locked the storage space. Deficiency is now compliant			
43 An operator of a licensed facility shall not permit hot beverages in areas that are occupied by the children receiving services at the licensed facility, including the outdoor play area.	43	Apr 18, 2023	Apr 18, 2023
Comments: While Quality Assurance monitor was on site, one staff member had a coffee. Hot beverages are not permitted in areas occupied by children. The educator immediately poured her hot beverage. Deficiency is now compliant			

General Comments Visit done at the center for a monitoring inspection. Ratio was respected. During the visit, the Quality Assurance monitor verified: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - storage space for toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies; - Indoor play area materials and equipment - incident records - if children's personal belongings are easily accessible, labelled with the name of the child, only used for the intended child and stored separately for each child.
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General Comments

During the inspection, the QAM was able to observe indoor play, snack time and circle time. Positive interactions between staff and educators were observed.

Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the administrator regarding the infant spaces at the facility. If the service is not offered, an application for change must be submitted in order to remove the spaces from the license. Quality Assurance monitor left an application for change form at the facility and is available to answer any questions from the operator regarding this.
