There are sufficient and safe washroom facilities to meet the needs of the number and ages of children enrolled in the facility. The facility has a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for each of the following: toxic products, chemical products, cleaning supplies and medication.

However, in the basement kitchen, a bottle of WD-40 was observed by the Quality Assurance Monitor. The administrator informs the QA Monitor that the kitchen door is locked before the afterschool children arrive at the facility. There are no children in the area at the time of the inspection.

During the visit, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed indoor free play, snack and circle time. She was also able to observe children transitioned to outdoor play.
