Comments: During the monitoring inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that in one classroom, three children had not been signed in or out on previous days. The administrator must ensure that children's daily attendance records are completed promptly and accurately. The educator immediately added the departure times and noted that the children were absent on those days. Deficiency is now compliant

<p>The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site mid-morning to conduct a monitoring inspection.</p> <p>The following element were verified:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Washroom - Diaper Change - Storage Space - Personal Belonging - Nutrition - Outdoor Play Area - Outdoor Play Area Materials & Equipment <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the administrator regarding designation requirements. The administrator confirmed that the Quality Improvement Plan is current, and all eligible educators are actively completing their required 10 hours of professional learning per renewal year.</p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor observed a washcloth, a bowl, and a paintbrush on the changing table. For sanitation purposes, the administrator must ensure that the changing mat is used exclusively for diaper changes. The administrator promptly removed the items, sanitized the art supplies, and set them aside on the counter.</p>

General Comments

During the monitoring inspection, the following were observed: children playing outdoors, engaging in risky play, transitioning indoors, washing hands, participating in free play, having lunch (lunch boxes), and transitioning to nap time.
