General Comments

Monitoring Inspection:

Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities this morning including mark making, dramatic play, water and sand play, painting opportunities, puzzles and games.

Purposeful planning is evident through documentation displayed within the learning environments. Each learning environment is set-up with variety of interesting materials and invitations for the children to explore freely. Materials have been added to support the children's current interests (cars, babies, The Big Bad Wolf, animals, birthdays, snow, snowmen and skunks). Documentation includes connections to NB Curriculum Framework.

The Infant Room has an ongoing large painting project displayed, where the infants have explored paint on a

large canvas. Photos and documentation about their experience are displayed beside the piece of art. Educators have plans to have the children add to the painting each month as well as add to the documentation. The children in the Twos Room have been interested in the "Big Bad Wolf", educators have created a sensory table inspired by the Three Little Pigs for the children to explore. A small group of children in the Two/Threes Room were observed exploring paint, bubble wrap and cars. The educators in the Three/Fours Room had setup a Snowman Scavenger Hunt, the children were observed working together to find snowmen and their number around the room.

Monthly fire drills are documented. Daily attendance forms are complete and accurate. Chicken, potatoes and vegetables were served for lunch. New staff file (2) review was completed, all required documents are in place.
