A monthly review and maintenance plan must be completed on all stationary equipment showing: the review and repair dates; the action required and taken; and the name of the staff completing the review. The operator informs the Quality Assurance Monitor that a daily check of the stationary equipment and outdoor play area is completed, however, it is not always documented. The review and maintenance plan must be documented at least once a month.

## **General Comments**

Visit done at the center for a monitoring inspection.

The Quality Assurance Monitor followed-up (from previous monitoring inspection) on child record files and administrative records maintained on site.

During the visit, The Quality Assurance Monitor also verified these elements:

- Child to staff ratio
- If required documents were posted in a visible and prominent place in the facility

The QA monitor was able to observe children play indoors and have snack. Positive interaction between educators and children were observed. Educators facilitate children's learning by engaging in play and asking open-end questions.

The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the administrator regarding designation requirements. The administrator and the educators are working on their PL hours and requirements will be met by the end of the renewal year. The administrator informs QA Monitor that the parent committee is doing great, and the quality improvement plan is up to date.
