<p>General Comments</p> <p>On the morning of my visit the children were enjoying lots of play time indoors as it was a very rainy day.</p> <p>In the 3's room, children were finishing snack as I arrived. The educators shared that the children have been learning about the dentist, teeth, and healthy eating. There was evidence of this around the room and recent documentation is posted throughout the space.</p> <p>After snack, children washed up and had free time before they moved into centres. The educators kept the lights dimmed with music playing which allowed for a nice atmosphere for a rainy day. The room and washroom are both very clean and organized. I observed children playing with connectors, small animal figurines, and the dramatic play area.</p> <p>The children have large bins labelled with their names for their lunch bags and nap materials. These are easily accessible to the children which promotes independence. Please make sure their water bottles are labelled with their names as well.</p> <p>In the 4's room, I also took note of the dimmed lights and twinkle lights with music playing which created a cozy atmosphere. Children were also finishing up snack. Their room has been learning about space and astronauts and this was also evident around the room. The children played with puppets, pop-its, and microphones after snack. Children were excited to tell me about Show and Tell tomorrow and their puddle jumping adventure that they were going on later that morning. The room and washroom are also kept very clean.</p> <p>When I went to the second 4's room, I opened the door, entered the space and no educator was present. The children said hello to me and told me their teacher had gone to the foyer. Approximately two minutes later, their</p>

teacher returned. She told me she was filling out the calendar in the foyer for this week's activities. Please note that children cannot remain unsupervised at any time.

In the 4's room, children were coloring and had access to scissors, glue, and different types of paper. This room has a wonderful collage of family photos and children were eager to show me this display.

The foyer is a lovely space that is also organized and clean. All necessary documentation is posted on the parent board.
