<p>General Comments</p> <p>Children were observed eating snack today and having circle time during today's monitoring inspection.</p> <p>There was evidence of planned programming and connections to the curriculum in all three rooms. Newsletters, family photos, pictures of the children and learning stories are posted throughout the rooms as well.</p> <p>Rooms were very clean, organized and have well thought out furniture arrangements to create defined learning areas. Materials were accessible in baskets and are labelled with both print and pictures of the contents.</p> <p>In the 4/5 room the educator was reading a story about winter animals. She shared that after reading "The Mitten" during a previous week, that the children have really enjoyed learning about animals. She is expanding on this interest in the room. The educator showed patience and genuine interest when the children wanted to share during the story. She posed lots of open-ended questions to the children and allowed plenty of time for sharing.</p> <p>In the 4's room, children were finishing up snack. The educator shared that today is the 100th day of preschool for this group. A party is being planned for later in the week and children have had the opportunity to create their own party. The educator helped write down the children's ideas to create posters for their party. The educator sat with the children while they ate snack and displayed patience and kindness when speaking. Children were familiar with the routine and could choose an activity once they finished snack.</p> <p>The 3's room was preparing to go outside during my observations. Both educators created a smooth transition for the children from the classroom to the foyer. Children were encouraged to practice independence and try to put on their outdoor clothing, but the educators were on hand to assist. Children had ample time to try these skills on their own and were not rushed. The educators shared their enthusiasm about the snowfall with the children. Head counts were done throughout this transition to ensure the group remained together. As children were finishing getting ready, the educator asked questions such as "Who sees something green?" to keep the children engaged while they waited for their friends.</p>
