Comments: COVID-19 Recovery Phase: Group Logs were not being used on site. This log must be completed daily. Staff's temperature must be recorded on this log daily. Appendix E "Parental Confirmation and Acknowledgement of Screening Responsibility" was not completed for any of the children. To be completed and added to the children's file. Signage was not posted regarding the need for screening prior to entry for essential visitors. Inspector was not screened upon arrival. Screening questionnaire to be posted at the door where parents pick up. All essential visitors must follow screening procedures including a temperature check prior to entering.			

<p>General Comments</p> <p>Completed renewal inspection today.</p> <p>Children were observed engaged in play outdoors and indoors. Outdoors, children were observed engaging in risky play, and supporting one another to succeed (ex: a child helped another child climb the ladder to go down the slide). Educator modelled supportive encouragement and problem solving behaviors. A sense of belonging was evident amongst many of the children within the program.</p> <p>Hand washing routine observed upon entry to facility.</p> <p>The children have an established routine and appear to be very content within their environment. The room was set up with many choices for the children. Apparent interests included cooperative games (ex: Battle Ship, Checkers, Guess-Who?), creative art, dramatic play, and mark making using the various materials available within their environment. The children also recounted what they enjoy doing in the gym when they use this space. Educator engages in conversations with the children at their level.</p> <p>The children moved freely amongst their space and activities with ease and engaged in reading, singing and</p>

conversation with one another.

Programing is documented and purposeful planning was evident during the time of inspection.

Ensure all children with medical conditions/protocols (ex: Epilepsy, Severe Asthma etc.) have an Essential Routine Services Emergency Plan (see Appendix 5 within Operator Manual) completed and kept on site. Ensure these are updated for 2 children who currently attend. Going forward, these should be reviewed annually by the parent.

Educator to be provided with a copy of the COVID-19 Recovery Phase document, required forms and a thermometer to be kept on site.
