### General Comments

A monitoring inspection took place in the afternoon on May 24, 2024 and focused on various aspects of the childcare facility, including outdoor activities, educator interactions, facility maintenance, and curriculum implementation.

During the inspection, children were observed participating in outdoor free play. The children showed a keen interest in activities such as jump rope, drawing with chalk, and driving toy cars. Educators were seen using positive language and giving gentle reminders to guide the children. Notably, educators actively participated in the children's activities and included their own interests in the documentation. This engagement highlights the educators' commitment to fostering a supportive and interactive environment.

The facility maintains all required records and documents for at least one year, ensuring comprehensive record-keeping. A daily incident log is kept up-to-date, and incident report forms are completed with parents being notified in the event of reportable incidents. Parents of children present at the center are granted entry at any time, reflecting an open and welcoming policy.

The environment of the facility is designed to be inviting and stimulating. Children are greeted with enthusiasm upon arrival. The room setup encourages play, with areas such as the art area, library, kitchen, and dramatic play areas reflecting ideas from web/learning stories. Books and materials are selected based on the children's interests, contributing to a rich and engaging learning environment. The facility is well-equipped with a varied supply of appropriate equipment, materials, books, and toys, and features several well-defined learning centers, including areas for building, reading, dramatic play, and art.

Outdoor stationary equipment is surrounded by protective surfacing of appropriate depth, ensuring the safety of the children during play. This attention to safety measures underscores the facility's commitment to providing a secure environment for all activities.
