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## **General Comments**

A renewal inspection was conducted on Friday, October 22, 2021.

Children were observed in the following areas: Inside and outside play, snack, and gym time.

Discussed with the operator that unless the school-age program rakes the mulch under the stationary equipment at Hampton Elementary School the After School Program is unable to use this area. Areas under the fall zones are not raked to proper depth and the bare ground covering is showing underneath causing a safety hazard to children using the equipment.

The children were observed having meaningful conversations with their peers and with their educators. The educators were observed speaking respectfully and kindly to the children and having positive interactions.
