The first group was observed arriving from school. The children washed hands and sat at the tables for snack. Granola bars and water was served to the children. The children each grabbed a notebook where they wrote in for about 5 minutes. The educator then discussed several types of apples and showed pictures to the children. The children were observed playing with play dough, painting, and air hockey.							
The second group was observed playing outside. The children were observed playing with parachutes, sand							

There was a variety of materials for the kids to play with both inside and outside and planning and programming was evident in the indoor environment.

and sand toys, water play, catch, and Frisbee. The educators were observed engaging in conversations and

Hand washing was observed when the children arrived, before snack, and after playing outside.

The following records were reviewed: Incident logs, fire drills, menu substitutions, monthly maintenance plan for stationary equipment, and daily attendance sheets.

All staff files were viewed, and a random review of the children's files was completed.
