<p>General Comments</p> <p>A monitoring inspection occurred in the afternoon.</p> <p>The children were observed in both the indoor and outdoor environments, including the transition between the two.</p> <p>Upon arrival, the children were observed playing on the stationary equipment at the school prior to transitioning to the facility. Once at the facility, the children were observed eating snack, with handwashing occurring beforehand. Snack today was popcorn, granola bars, and water.</p> <p>Following snack, one group of children transitioned outdoors, where they were observed playing soccer. The group that remained indoors observed playing air hockey, engaging with Shopkins, and doing open-ended art at the table.</p>

General Comments

The educator indicated that the children are currently interested in loom bracelet making, Perler beads, and Lego.

Traffic areas are kept clean, and outdoor walkways are free of clutter. Toxic products such as cleaning agents are securely locked and inaccessible to children. The changing area is located within one metre of a sink, and diaper changing procedures are clearly posted.

Positive child guidance techniques were observed. The operator was seen engaging at the children's level, providing appropriate supervision, using encouraging language, offering choices, and assisting children with decision-making.

A clearly visible and prominent area was designated for the posting of the facility license, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additional documents reviewed included incident logs, daily attendance records, one staff file, a random review of ten children's files, and records of evacuation and monthly fire drills.
