- Ratio was respected during the visit
- Children's guidance is done in a respectful and positive way
- Posted in a visible and prominent place in the facility are the following documents: The license, inspection report, orders for compliance, daily routine, evacuation procedures, name of administrator, name and telephone number of QA Monitor and Inspector Life-threatening allergies and a notice to inform parents of the existence of a communicable disease.
- Parent's is being asked to notify the operator/director the reason why the child is absent, whether it's sickness or another reason
- When a child becomes ill, he/she is supervised and separated from the other children. That child is to be picked up within one hour of notification to parents.
- Management of potential illness forms are completed as required, discussion with the administrator on appendix 11 & 12 in the operator's manual.
- Parents are advised when a child has a communicable disease or illness, center does use the notice of illness form (appendix 13, in the operator's manual)
- Appendix 14-Managing illness in ELC facilities- parent's/guardian's role is given to all parents with the parent handbook
- The administrator-educator have a valid first aid certificate and a valid CPR certificate.
- All required documents were in the employee file.

Observations: When arriving at the center children were getting into free play. Some children were working on their book project and were drawing different kind of animal, others were making bracelets, some were working on a Lego construction while another group was playing in the dramatic corner.
