Staff interact with the children in a kind and positive manner. I observed staff playing and engaging in conversation with the children.

Curriculum is being documented in the form of learning stories. Binders are being kept for each child's work.

Cots are being stored in the washroom next to a mop and change area. Please check with Public Health to ensure Health safety is being complied with.

A child became ill at time of visit. Management of illness guidelines are being followed. The child was separated from the other children, a parent was notified and picked up the child within an hour, potential illness form was signed and attendance record reflected the early departure.

Filing system for all required documentation to meet regulations are organized and complete.

It is my understanding that there will be a change in administrators within the facility on November 25, 2019. Please advise your Quality Assurance Monitor of these changes.

Please ensure that walk ways to outdoor play space remain sanded as required to avoid falls and accidents.
