General Comments

Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility to conduct the License Renewal Inspection while the children were transitioning from the indoor play environment to the outdoor play environment. License staff saw the educators count the children before going into the fenced in playground and multiple times before leaving the fenced in playground to go inside for lunch.

While outside, the children played in the newly fallen snow. A group of children gathered at the imaginary campfire while another group of children played on the ride-on toys, shovels and the snow fort cubes.

The children laughed and had rich conversations with their friends while outside.

Throughout the inspection, the educators encouraged the children to problem solve when they were disagreeing with their friends. The educators used positive language when speaking with the children.

The indoor play environment was very cleaned and organized and had a good variety of play resources for the children to play with.

During nap time, those children who did not nap, engaged in invitations of play set up by the educators.

Later in the afternoon, the school-aged children arrived at the school-aged program. When the children arrived, they got dressed into their outdoor clothing and went outdoors to play. While outdoors, a couple of children went to swing on the swings while other children were played a game by forming a circle around one of the large trees found on the playground. Another group of children played with chunks of snow, scraping the snow on the side of the building while other children played on the climbing structure.

Licensing staff recommends the facility for their renewal of their license.
