<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to conduct a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival, the children were outside playing in the fenced in playground. One group of children were playing in a large wooden boat, rocking it from side to side. Others were observed playing on a small play structure and looking for worms. One Educator was observed asking the children what song they would like to sing together. The children sang along to several songs such as "Twinkle Twinkle Little Star" and the alphabet.</p> <p>Later in the morning the children lined up at the fenced and raced across the playground. Children who did not race were heard clapping and cheering for their peers. A gentle reminder was heard before the children lined up to go inside. A headcount was observed before the group entered the school. Once inside, the children removed their outdoor gear in the hallway outside the classroom and got their indoor shoes on. Each child has their own labelled cubby and basket inside the classroom for personal belongings. One Educator was heard offering to help children who needed a tissue for their nose before washing hands and gathering together on a large carpet.</p> <p>Once all the children were settled, one Educator read "The Very Impatient Caterpillar". The Educator was expressive and engaging while reading to the children. After the story, the children were called to wash their hands before sitting down to have lunch. Some children had lunch from the school cafeteria while others brought their lunch from home. The Educators sat with the children as they ate, offering their assistance when needed. An extra staff member set out cots and the children's napping materials as the group ate lunch. The transition from lunch time to nap time was smooth.</p> <p>Only positive child guidance was observed during today's Monitoring Inspection. All Educators were attentive to the needs of the children, offering hugs, back rubs and taking the time to talk through any big feelings the children were having. Staff and child profiles were reviewed on site today. The files contained all required documents. Fire drills are being performed monthly and were posted in the classroom.</p>
