Comments: In 8 children's files verified, three files were missing the Immunization records or exemption.

Comments: Several staff files did not have a copy of confirmation of their registration to the Introduction to Early Childhood Education course. Staff files must hold the confirmation email that they are registered for the Introduction to Early Childhood Education online course. Administrator printed all confirmation of staff registered and inserted in staff's files. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: One staff file was missing the Social Development check. Administrator printed the copy and inserted it in the staff's file. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: One staff did not have her First Aid Certificate. Administrator confirmed that this staff member is not left alone with children.

Comments: In 8 children's files verified, three files were missing the Immunization records or exemption.
