Inspector recommend all staff read Section 8.1.3 Child-to-staff ratios for mixed age group (pages 57 to 59 of the Operator Manual Full-time and Part-Time Early Learning and Childcare Centres, to understand the ratios calculation for mixed group. Deficiency will be compliant once recommendation from Public Health received. During time of renewal inspection toy bins were observed stored in the sleep room.

General Comments

COVID-19

Inspector was completely screened upon entering the facility. COVID-19 logs and documents are kept on site and accessible at all time. In order to respect room capacity a new group log was created. Inspector mentioned groups logs should represent the children there on that day. If part-time children attend then it should be visible on the group logs.

During time of inspection the inspector discussed maximum capacity in the facility in relations to approved spaces, room capacity in the afterschool room and the preschool room. Children were moved from the afterschool group to the preschool group to respect room capacity, new COVID group logs were created. Operator is to communicate with the Quality Assurance Monitor and discuss room capacity and ratios.
