Regarding the non-compliances in the child files, all children end the program in June. The Quality Assurance Monitor (QAM) had a conversation over the phone with the Administrator on the importance of obtaining complete information and having complete child profiles. Administrator has agreed to completing files in accordance with Regulation. Administrator also informed QAM that modifications will be brought to the centre's Early Childhood Program and be implemented in the fall.

Administrator has confirmed with QAM over the phone that the First Aid Kit has been reorganized.
