Administrator indicates that transportation services are not currently being offered due to staffing. The bus is currently being stored off site and could not be verified during the time of inspection.

Inspector observed that each child has their individual space to store their personal belonging which were labelled with the child's name. However, there are extra storage spaces in which children's belongings are being stored. Inspector recommends that each child's belonging be placed in their assisgned storage spaces.
