Comments: 2 of the audited children's files are missing a consent for bathing in the event of illness or soiled clothing. Recommendation that Administrator review all children's files to ensure that all required information is indicated.

Comments: Inspector found a used tissue in a toy bin in the indoor play area. This was addressed with an educator, who removed it immediately to ensure that the indoor play area is maintained clean. Deficiency is now compliant			
31(3) An operator shall maintain the outdoor play area of a licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children.	31(3)	Jun 05, 2023	
Comments: Inspector found a rusted cooking pan in the outdoor play area. Recommendation that Administrator verify all outdoor materials to ensure that the outdoor play area is maintained safe and free of hazards.			
31(6) The outdoor play area of a full-time or part-time early learning and childcare centre at which services are provided to infants or preschool children shall be enclosed with a fence at least 1.22 m in height with a gate that is secured at all times when the children are present.	31(6)	Jun 05, 2023	
Comments: The preschool play area is enclosed by a gated fenced, however the fence does not close properly. Administrator must ensure that the gate is repaired in order to ensure that it opens and closes with ease.			
38(3) An operator of a licensed facility shall provide one potty chair or training seat for each group of three children who are being toilet-trained.	38(3)	Jun 05, 2023	
Comments: Inspector observed that there is no training seats for children who are currently being toilet trained. As potty training is an important event in a child's life, using a potty training seat will make the child feel more secure and stable. Administrator must ensure that one potty chair or training seat is provided for each group of 3 children being toilet trained.

<p>Comments: 3 bottles of shaving cream were found underneath the kitchen sink. The cabinet was locked with a child safety lock and the kitchen door was not locked. A discussion was had with the administrator and the kitchen door was locked. Deficiency is now compliant</p>

<p>Comments: Management of potential illness forms are filled out as required. However, inspector observed that the full year and the license number were not indicated on a management of potential illness form. This was added by the Administrator during the inspection. Deficiency is now compliant</p>			
<p>50(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall maintain a chronologically filed daily incident log relating to the health, security and well-being of the children receiving services at the licensed facility.</p>	<p>50(1)</p>	<p>May 05, 2023</p>	
<p>Comments: Inspector observed 5 incident logs that did not indicate the care that was provided to the child by the educator. Inspector also observed that not all incident logs have the full date of when the incident occurred. Administrator must ensure that all required information is indicated on the incident logs.</p>			

General Comments
<p>During the Renewal Inspection, Inspector observed the children arriving to the facility after having played outside at the local park. Inspector observed children playing with puzzles, making bracelets, making origami as well as playing games. Inspector observed the lunch period as well as the rest period.</p> <p>Inspector observed positive interactions between the educators and the children, such as gentle reminders, helping children label their emotions, helping children problem solve as well as offering calming strategies when necessary.</p> <p>Inspector reminded Administrator to ensure that programming must be kept on-site.</p> <p>Ratio was respected during the time of the inspection.</p>
