Quality Assurance Monitor inspected the following during the monitoring visit:

Quality Assurance Monitor and Administrator discussed the arrival of a new inclusion support worker beginning soon. Quality Assurance Monitor confirmed with Administrator that the inclusion support worker is able to take the supported child to the washroom, or into other areas, as required for transitions given that the Educator of the child's classroom is knowledgeable to their whereabouts and continues to count the supported child in ratio. Quality Assurance Monitor surveyed 5 child profiles. All are in compliance.

Quality Assurance Monitor notes that child profile of child who no longer needs emergency essential routine services and emergency plan should have this indicated on the child profile with a parent initial or a new profile completed.

Quality Assurance Monitor observed children exchanging Valentine's day cards, freeplay, bathroom time, preparation for outside play, and outside play.
