<p>Comments: While adding new staff members into the system, one educator had an ECE course from a college that is not recognized for licensing requirements (after referring to appendix 25 of the operator's manual). The operator must enroll the staff in question to the Introduction to ECE course or provide proof that the college/course is recognized or exempt.</p> <p>The staff in question is enrolled to the 30-hour course; however the staff must be enrolled to the 90 hours to meet requirements (if ECE certificate is not recognized)</p>

<p>Comments: When the Quality Assurance Monitor arrive on site, the QAM rang the bell 3 times, and no one answered the door. The Quality Assurance Monitor could hear children playing inside. The QAM called the facility twice with no answer and the answering machine was full. The QAM called the administrator's personal phone after 15 minutes. The administrator informed the QAM that 2 educators were inside, and 2 educators were at school for pick up. The administrator shared that the educators might not have heard the bell nor the phone ring.</p> <p>When children are present, parents shall have access to the facility at all times. The operator must ensure that educators are able to grant access to the parents. If a parent were to arrive during that time, they would not have had access.</p> <p>A few minute later, the school age children arrived with the educators, the QAM could enter the facility. Deficiency is now compliant.</p>

Comments: The QAM observed a very limited amount of material for the children in the outdoor play area. Children were observed either sitting, standing or playing with little rocks. Children could benefit from a variation of materials. The outdoor play area materials and equipments must be varied and in sufficient quantity for all children present.

<p>The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site for a monitoring inspection.</p> <p>The QAM verified these items:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Ratio and maximum number of children -Outdoor play area materials and equipment -New staff members files. <p>During the visit, the ratio was respected.</p> <p>The QAM had a discussion with the educator in charge regarding the first aid and CPR certificate of one educator. The QAM was not able to determine if the certificate was valid or not. The operator must ensure that the first aid and CPR certificate is from a course recognized by WorkSafeNB. A proof via email can be sent to the Quality Assurance Monitor after communicating with WorkSafeNB.</p> <p>The QAM observed, the children eating a snack and playing outside.</p>
