<p>Comments: During the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed a child crying for an extended period without receiving the necessary attention from educators. The child was seen walking to his bin containing personal items in an attempt to rest, which indicated he was tired and wanted to sleep. The child was also observed refusing to eat during lunch.</p> <p>The QAM noted a lack of positive child guidance, as educators were not anticipating or responding to the child's needs. Educators are expected to remain attentive, responsive, and adjust the daily routine as required to support children's well being.</p> <p>After it was noticed that the child did not want to eat, an educator picked him up, and the child fell asleep within seconds. He was then placed on his cot for nap time.</p> <p>Following a discussion with the administrator, she confirmed that she will speak with staff to ensure they consistently use positive child guidance strategies and remain attentive to children's individual needs.</p> <p>The QAM recommends that the daily routine be adjusted so educators can be more responsive to children who may require rest at times outside the scheduled nap period.</p> <p>Deficiency is now compliant</p>			

<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor was on site to conduct a monitoring inspection. During the inspection, the following elements were verified:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Administrative records maintained on-site</li> <li>- Daily routine</li> <li>- Child guidance</li> <li>- Rest area</li> <li>- Washrooms</li> <li>- Storage space</li> <li>- Personal belongings</li> <li>- Diaper changing</li> <li>- Outdoor play area</li> </ul>
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General Comments

The QAM had a discussion with the administrator regarding designation requirements. The administrator reported that one educator is still working on completing her 10 Professional Learning hours, while all other educators are on track. The administrator also confirmed that the QIP is up to date.

While reviewing documents on-site, the QAM observed that there was no documentation of menu substitutions. The administrator stated that the centre follows the menu and has not had to make any substitutions. She acknowledged that if menu changes occur in the future, they must be documented and confirmed that a system will be put in place.

During the inspection, children were observed playing indoors, eating lunch, and, for one group, transitioning to nap time.
