The 4/5 year old room is the only room that meets this requirement, all other rooms must place bank paper and mark-making materials on low, open shelves.

Quality Assurance Monitor observed a prevalence of crafts using pre-cut materials on display throughout the facility. Discussed with Administrator that educators should promote creative art experiences that focus on and value the process of the experience. Recommend that they reflect on curricular expectations of early learning centers and reach out to the Curriculum consultant as needed.
