32(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall provide indoor play area materials and equipment that are (b) arranged on low, open shelves and accessible to the children receiving services at the licensed facility, Comments: The inspector observed that art materials in one classroom were placed on a high shelf, making them inaccessible to the children. All materials and equipment must be placed on low, open shelves to ensure they are easily accessible. The inspector informed the educator of this requirement, and the educator immediately relocated the materials to a low shelf, making them accessible to the children. Deficiency is now compliant.	32(1)(b)	Aug 18, 2026	Aug 14, 2026
39(2) A licensed facility shall have a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for each of the following: (a) toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies; Comments: The inspector observed that a bottle of Lysol cleaner was stored in a low bathroom cupboard in one classroom and was not secured under lock and key. All toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies must be locked and inaccessible to children. The inspector informed the administrator and the administrator immediately relocated the Lysol cleaner to a locked storage area, ensuring it was inaccessible to children. General Comments
The inspector is on site to conduct the renewal inspection. During the inspection, the inspector observed the morning snack, children transitioning to outdoor play, and outdoor activities, including children coloring with chalk on cardboard and making bubbles. The inspector also observed the lunch period and rest time. In one classroom children are engaged in playing bingo with numbers and letters. Positive child guidance practices are observed throughout the inspection. Educators spoke softly and respectfully to the children and sang songs during diaper-changing routines. A discussion is held with the administrator to ensure that all children's personal belongings, including water bottles and lunch boxes, are clearly labelled with the child's name.

General Comments

Another discussion is held with the administrator to clarify that eligible educators must complete the required 10 hours of professional development before the permit expiration date of September 30, 2026.

The ratio is respected throughout the inspection.
