Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that the latest renewal inspection is not posted in a visible and prominent place in the facility. The administrator informed the inspector that they only posted the most recent inspection reports which are both monitoring inspection reports. The operator must ensure that the renewal inspection report and monitoring inspection report are posted inside the facility.			
24(1) For the purposes of subsection 20(1) of the Act, the following records and documents shall be maintained on the premises of a licensed facility: (f) daily attendance records of the children on forms provided by the Minister.	24(1)(f)	Oct 19, 2023	Oct 19, 2023
Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that 5 reason for absence codes are missing on this week's daily attendance sheet and that the arrival time of one child is not specified. The operator must ensure that times are recorded immediately upon the child's arrival and departure, and that the record reflects all children present at any given time. The operator must also ensure that attendance records are completed, showing all absences and detailing the reason of the absence. During the inspection, an educator and an administrator wrote the reasons for absence and the missing arrival time on the daily attendance sheet. Deficiency is now compliant.			
27 An operator of a licensed facility shall obtain the written consent of a parent or guardian of a child receiving services at the licensed facility before doing any of the following: (f) permitting the child to participate in an outing.	27(f)	Oct 19, 2023	
Comments: During the renewal inspection, the administrator advised the inspector that the facility offers transportation and that during the summer months children are transported to different parks and sport facilities around the Greater Moncton area. The administrator informed the inspector that parents are sent an online consent form but that a written signature is not required. The operator must ensure parents sign separate consent forms for field trips. These consent forms should outline the date, time of departure and return, destination and purpose of trip and any special considerations.

<p>Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed a damaged book in the play area. During the inspection, an educator removed the book from the shelf and informed the inspector they that would try to repair the book. The operator must ensure all material, equipment and furnishings are in good repair and are repaired or discarded once broken. Deficiency is now compliant.</p>			
<p>46(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall only administer medication to a child receiving services at the licensed facility in the following cases: (a) the medication is provided by the child's parent or guardian.</p>	<p>46(1)(a)</p>	<p>Oct 19, 2023</p>	
<p>Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed 3 bottles of Diphenhydramine (Bendaryl) and one bottle of Ibuprofen in a locked medication box. The administrator informed the inspector that these medications are provided by the facility for children who may require them. These medications must be removed from the facility. The operator must ensure that the only medication provided by the facility is acetaminophen. All other medications must be provided by the parent or guardian of the child and must be labelled with the child's name and the dosage.</p>			
<p>46(2) Despite subsection (1), the operator of a licensed facility may administer acetaminophen to a child if the parent or guardian of the child gives written or oral consent.</p>	<p>46(2)</p>	<p>Oct 19, 2023</p>	
<p>Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that 1 out of 3 administration of acetaminophen form is not signed by the parent or guardian. The operator shall require the parent or guardian to give a written acknowledgement when the child is picked up at the licensed facility that acetaminophen was administered with their consent.</p>			

**General Comments**

During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed snack time, indoor free play, and outdoor free play. While on-site, the inspector observed several guided sport activities being offered in the gym.

The inspector observed that educators are attentive to the needs on the children. During the inspection, the inspector observed that a child pulled out a loose tooth. The child informed an educator that his tooth fell out and the educator was quick at helping him out by offering the child tissues along with a plastic bag so that they could bring their tooth home safely.

The ratio was respected during the visit.
