Comments: One educator did not hold a valid first aid and CPR certificate. Administrator and educators must hold a valid first aid and CPR certificate. Once educator receives her certificate, a copy can be sent to QA monitor.

Comments: In one of 8 child files verified, the medicare number was missing. All child record files must include the child's name, address, birth date and Medicare number.			
24(1) For the purposes of subsection 20(1) of the Act, the following records and documents shall be maintained on the premises of a licensed facility: (b) child records that include: (ii) the name, address and telephone number of the child's medical practitioner.	24(1)(b)(ii)	Jun 23, 2023	
Comments: In 2 of the 8 child record files verified the full address of the medical practitioner was missing. All child record files must include the medical practitioner's name, address and phone number.			
24(1) For the purposes of subsection 20(1) of the Act, the following records and documents shall be maintained on the premises of a licensed facility: (b) child records that include: (iv) the name, address and telephone number of at least two individuals authorized by the child's parent or guardian to pick up the child and to be contacted in case of an emergency if the parent or guardian cannot be reached,	24(1)(b)(iv)	Jun 23, 2023	
Comments: In one of the 8 child record files verified, the emergency contacts were missing. The name, address and telephone number of at least 2 emergency contact must be included in all child record files.			
24(1) For the purposes of subsection 20(1) of the Act, the following records and documents shall be maintained on the premises of a licensed facility: (c) staff member records that include (vii) a copy of a valid first aid certificate and a valid cardiopulmonary resuscitation certificate for each administrator and educator.	24(1)(c)(vii)	Jun 30, 2023	
Comments: In one educator's file, the first aid and CPR certificate was missing. Once the educator receives the certificate, it must be inserted in the file.

9(1) The child-to-staff ratio is one educator for each of the following groups of children of the same age receiving services at a full-time or part-time early learning and childcare centre: (a) three infants or fewer; (b) five children or fewer who are two years of age; (c) eight children or fewer who are three years of age; (d) ten children or fewer who are four years of age or older, but who are not yet attending school; and (e) 15 school-age children or fewer.	9(1)	Jun 16, 2023	Jun 16, 2023
Comments: When QA monitor arrived on site, the child-to-staff ratio was not respected. Child-to-staff ratio must be respected at all times. Soon after, another staff arrived and the child-to-staff ratio was respected. Deficiency is now compliant.			
9(5) The number of children grouped at a full-time or part-time early learning and childcare centre shall not be more than the number that requires two educators.	9(5)	Jun 16, 2023	Jun 16, 2023
Comments: When QA monitor arrived on site, the group size in the gym was exceeding the requirements of 2 educators. The maximum number of children in a group must not exceed the requirement of 2 educators. Soon after, another staff member arrived, and the group was divided in 2. Deficiency is now compliant.
