The inspector takes he staff-to-child ratio and found that two groups were each over ratio by one child, with one educator for 16 children in both groups. Ratio for the afterschool children is one educator per 15 children. The administrator arrived onsite; the ratio is now respected. The operator must ensure that the staff-to-child ratio is always maintained within the same age groups. Deficiency is now compliant. | | | | | | | |
