General Comments

Monitoring inspection performed. Covid guidelines are followed and I was screened and my name documented on the daily log sheet for essential visitors. This facility continues to check children's temperatures. Always be vigilant with washing hands at all prescribed times. Refer to appendix 38 and 39 for guidance.

I would recommend that children wear indoor footwear for safety reasons (prevention of slips and falls), and for emergency situations if children and staff had to vacate the building in a hurry (a fire).

Children were observed involved in a variety of individual and group activities. I observed educators engaged with the children - listening to a story, making Christmas cards and other Christmas decorations, singing songs. Children were observed in dramatic play. Educators could extend the learning by adding other materials to the play opportunity.

This facility is meeting the educational requirements at this time as all staff have either completed the 1 year ECE or the 90 hour Intro to ECE.

Just an observation when children's bottoms are being changed, all other children need to be supervised. I am recommending that you do this so you can still observe the other children at the same time and intervene if necessary. Most of this group is potty trained, but one child had an accident today. Usually the educator takes all the children to the washroom before snacks and lunches.

I did not observed outdoor play, but perhaps children will get out to play after nap when it warms up.
