<p>Monitoring visit performed. A few compliances to address. Covid protocols are followed and staff are masking and 2-5 year olds in common areas when required. Administrative records were reviewed - child attendance, infant records, fire drills, outdoor checklist verified including staff vaccination status- all in order. Staff information was also reviewed. Upon arrival, all children were involved in a variety of activities - playing with Barbies, cars, coloring, experimenting with blubber, play doh. Children were listening to stories, playing simon says. Themes for the week in some rooms were about Dr. Seuss, and Nursery Rhymes.</p>

General Comments

Educators were observed engaged with children and participating in activities, reading to the children and providing assistance when required speaking to children in a positive tone.
All children were observed going down for a nap or given a quiet time.
