General Comments
<p>Upon arrival of licensing staff Dominique Boudreau and Hannah Mitchell, the children in the front 3 and 4-year-old group were doing circle time. The children and educators were heard counting together and identifying today's date and the weather. An educator took out a book about community and community workers to read with the children. The infants were doing hand and feet painting. The back 3 and 4-year-old group were engaged in free play. Some children were playing with dolls and others in imaginary play. The educator put music on and the children started dancing. The 2-year-old group were painting winter trees with their handprints. The front 3 and 4-year-old group split into two groups. Some were engaging in free play, playing with marble races and trucks, and others were practicing the letter R. The children were seen tracing the letter R and colouring things that start with the letter R. In the infant group, the educator was heard singing songs to the children before helping them wash hands for snack. The preschool groups started cleaning up their toys, washing hands and settling down for snack. The educators were sitting with the children as they ate.</p> <p>After snack, the 2-year-old group washed their hands and sat down with books while the educator cleaned up. They used the washroom and started getting ready to go outside. The back 3 and 4-year-old group washed their hands and lined up to go get dressed to go outside. The front 3 and 4-year-old groups also used the washroom, washed hands, and got dressed to go outside. The infants sat at the table with the educator to play with Playdoh. While outside, the children were seen playing in the play structure and digging in the snow with trucks. The children engaged in imaginary play, pretending to be wolves and howling. The educators were spaced out and engaging in their play.</p> <p>The groups returned inside for lunch. The children washed their hands and played as the educators prepared their lunches. The children sat at the table to eat, and the educators sat with them. After lunch, the back 3 and 4-year-old group and 2-year-old group washed their hands, and the educators prepared their nap mats. children got settled on their mats and read books. The infants got settled for nap. The front 3 and 4-year-old groups engaged in free play as the educators cleaned up and prepared the centres for quiet time.

The classroom walls are decorated with recent artwork, learning stories, and pictures. The educators are attentive to the children. Staff files were reviewed. A conversation was had with the operator as licensing staff overheard an educator asking a child if they wanted to go in a time-out. Please ensure positive child guidance techniques are used to redirect the children.
