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General Comments

When licensing staff arrived, one educator was present playing a game with a child while the other children were playing with magnetics and games. The space is set up with accessible resources located around the space reflecting the curriculum areas. Children's artwork was displayed on the two bulletin boards located in the room. The second educator arrived and both educators were observed having discussions with the children and allowing them a choice on plans for the day.

Educators gave a reminder of the transition for cleanup and when completed, children lined up at the door and one educator took attendance, an important practice to ensure each child is accounted for. Children visited the washroom prior to snack to wash their hands. Children and one educator sat at a table for snack building community around shared mealtimes.

Children were given a choice to visit the gym after snack and free play. The educators again took attendance as the children lined up to go. A reminder was given to each child before leaving to clean up their bags for home and a note was posted at the door to inform parents children were in the gym.

Children were able to choose from a variety of gym equipment to play games and sports. Each educator engaged in activities with the children and suggested different items to extend play. Parents came to the door of the gym for pickup of each child and educators ensured the attendance form was updated as each child left.

Educators were observed to be positive and engaged with the children allowing the children agency within their space and interests.
