Visit today to complete the renewal inspection.

There is a wonderful display of open-ended Halloween drawings made by the children. Posted webbings of ideas based on the children's interest were evident in the room.

Educators were observed to engage with the children in a kind and respectful manner. The children circulated the interest centers within the two groups. Some of the children were participating in a cooperative game of Connect 4. The educator was documenting the status of the game and encouraging others to participate.

Outdoor play was observed in addition to handwashing upon arrival, when coming in from the outdoor play area, and before snack.

Recommend adding more books that are of interest to the children.

Discussed removing the outdoor wooden cribbing that is rotten and breaking away in the spring of next year. Explored some possibilities for additions and enhancements to this outdoor play space.
