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General Comments

Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to conduct a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival the children in the 4/5-year-old class were preparing to go play outside. The infants, children in the 2- and 3-year-old classrooms were in the process of waking up from nap time. The facility was bright and welcoming with learning stories and pictures of the children on the walls outside the classrooms.

In the 2-year-old classroom one Educator was observed sanitizing cots while the other assisted the children with putting on their indoor shoes. New texture mats and Scoop Rocker Chairs have been added to the classroom. Some children were observed exploring the new materials, touching and walking on the textured mats. Another group of children sat together at the table using markers, colorful pieces of paper, glue to make crafts. An Educator explained the children have been showing an interest in rolling balls and cars for a ramp. To build on the children's interest, a small wooden ramp, balls and loose parts have recently been added to the indoor environment.

In the 3-year-old class, the children were all gathered around a large table with both Educators using colorful beads and string to make bracelets and necklaces. The infants were observed having snack before getting ready to go play outside. An extra staff member was on site today and was observed staying inside to sanitize materials in the classroom and have extra planning time.

Later in the afternoon the school age children arrived on site. Hands were washed as they entered the classroom and children who were hungry sat to eat afternoon snack. A lot of positive changes were noted in the school age classroom. There was a variety of play material such as age-appropriate books, card games, a large bin of Lego and a Lego table and a large dollhouse, all in good condition. Once everyone finished eating afternoon snack, the Educator was observed cleaning the tables and setting out colorful clay for the children to use.

Only positive child guidance was observed during today's Monitoring Inspection. The Educators spoke kindly when interacting with the children and were actively engaged throughout the visit. The Educators were heard communicating with one another to ensure supervision was maintained in the classrooms. The children
