General Comments

A renewal inspection occurred today.

Upon arrival to the childcare centre, Inspector observed the children transitioning to outside play. During outside play the preschool children were observed climbing the rock wall, playing soccer, driving cozy coup cars, engaged in reading a book with an educator, creating in the mud kitchen, drawing and mark making in the outside art centre.

The infants were observed in the outside play area, playing with balls, mark making in the art centre and playing on the toys in their designated area.

In the infant indoor play area, Inspector observed pictures of the children with their families, examples of the children's mark-making, learning stories of the children documenting walking, playing with balls, blocks and interacting with their siblings at the centre.

Throughout the childcare centre examples of celebrating diversity is evident. Documentation with languages spoken at the centre, pictures of homes and buildings from multiple countries, multicultural books, dolls, and music were also observed. Inspector observed multicultural music was playing softly in the background during the inspection.

Transitions were observed and occurring naturally from each activity. Handwashing was observed occurring often during the inspection. During the transition to quiet/nap time the children were observed engaged with manipulatives, puzzles, tuff tray activities, story time, and music with songs and instruments.

Educators were observed down at the level of the children when speaking and interacting with them, sitting with them during lunch time, using positive child guidance techniques including re-direction and speaking kindly and appropriately to them during the inspection.

Facility is recommended for license renewal, pending the recommendation from Fire.
