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General Comments -Unexpected morning visit to the establishment for a monitoring inspection -Ratio was respected during the visit -When acetaminophen or any other medication is administered to a child, the consent form is signed by the parent and kept into the children file. -Medication are stored in a locked cabinet upstairs for the upstairs room and-or downstairs and inaccessible to children -Medication used for anaphylactic shock (EPIPEN) are stored in the classroom designated to the child, inaccessible to children but easy to access for staff -During the visit, it was observed that all educators are engaged with children at their level providing support and having conversations. Open-end questions are asked and guidance is given in a respectful and kind way -Children's indoor play area is safe and clean. -Material and equipment proposed to children in the indoor play area are easily accessible on low, open shelves. It is varied and in sufficient quantity for all children present. -Infants are supervised at all times when eating or drinking -Allergy information on any child is posted in the food preparation area and each room -Drinking water is provided throughout the day -Every Wednesday parents provide snacks and lunch for their child, when food is brought from home it is labeled with the child's name and refrigerated or has an ice pack when needed. -Infants are working on a book of their favorite nursery rhymes. -Preschool groups are all in transition with new children starting daycare and other children moving up in another group. Observations: When arriving at the center children were getting ready to go play outside when coming in they had lunch and transition into naptime.
