I observed water on the floor and a wet wall in the boys bathroom in the afterschool area. I noticed that the shelf in the kitchen is bowed and I suggest anchors for cabinets and bookcases in the rooms. Please note that emergency contacts in child files need to be local, and original checks for staff should be in their files.
