General Comments

Monitoring Inspection performed.

Covid guidelines are being followed and licensing staff was screened and signed in on log sheet.. I did have a conversation with the administrator and discussed the bubble group log as this is still required. As per stated when changes occur on the log sheet please update it and include first and last names. This is for Public Health contact tracing purposes.

Attendance records and staff files were reviewed. As per discussed in order to verify staff child ratio it is important for educators to document arrivals and departures throughout the day, when they provide relief or to cover lunches, early morning drop off etc in the room they are supervising. I am not comfortable with 1 staff supervising 2 separate groups in the early morning or late drop off because of safety concerns.

Children were not observed in outdoor play today though the 3 and 4 year olds did get out early before it got really hot. There is a heat warning in place so children will remain indoors for the remainder of the day. It is important to be flexible and plan for these unanticipated events. Allow for opportunities for children to be active even when playing outside is not possible due to the heat. Purposefully planning ahead for these types of situations will help the day run smoothly when children are actively engaged and that incorporate children's interests. I observed some children involved in individual and small group play during my visit.

Children were observed going down for nap and educators played very soothing and calm music. Children that do not rest are permitted to get up and play quietly or play quiefly on their mat. There are recommendations stated in the length of time children should remain on a mat in the operator manual.
