<p>General Comments</p> <p>Monitoring inspection completed.</p> <p>Upon arrival children were enjoying a quiet time and were involved a variety of age-appropriate activities - creating with lego, coloring pictures and one of the children in the 4's group brought fake mustaches tattoos. The educator was applying them to the children's fingers instead of under their nose. Even their teacher participated in this activity and applied one to her finger. The children were having alot of fun with this activity and they were checking their mustaches in the mirror to see what they looked like.</p> <p>Another group of children were creating with play-doh and using their imagination with the brown play doh and pretending it was mud. They would apply it to the excavators and tractors. Other children were using cookie cutters and rollers to create cookies and other interesting things.</p> <p>No children were observed napping during my visit, though it is my understanding educators ask children if they would like to nap or have a rest and if so, the educators would set them up. Licensing staff observed that all children were playing cooperatively. One child appeared to be tired as the child was laying down with a pillow in the book area. He only remained there for 5 or so minutes but this may all that he needed to join his friends again. Therefore, it is recommended that Educators set up the cots for the younger age group to give all children the option to have a rest or to play quietly at the tables or in the other play stations. Resting is not to be confused with sleeping. It is only an opportunity for a child to take a break away from the regular busy routine. It is my understanding from the Educator that there are days when they do set up cots as they anticipate children needing a rest.</p> <p>Educators were observed engaged, and able to anticipate children's needs, offering choices and assisting children with making good choices.</p> <p>Administrative records were reviewed - attendance is tracked, fire inspections are recorded, outdoor checklists are completed, and incident reports are being signed off so parents are aware.</p>
