Comments: Deficiency is now compliant Educators always bring out a bookbag that contains a first aid when they go outside. First aid kit was missing from the bookbag that was brought outside when Quality Assurance Monitor checked it. Educator went inside and brought out a new bookbag with first aid kit inside.			

General Comments School age children were gone on an outing to the wetlands during today's inspection. Moving forward, please ensure that the financial records for this facility are maintained on-site at this location. Most of the children were playing outside when I arrived. Those who were not already out, were getting ready. I observed the educator ensuring that the children were properly sun screened before going outside. The outside play space offers different materials/surfaces that encourages and promotes different kinds of play. For example, children were observed playing in the outside kitchen, looking for worms, making houses for the worms they found, playing in the sand, on the small dome, relaxing on stage that is covered in turf, etc. Some children found a bubble machine that needed bubbles, educators were quick to find some bubble solution to put in it. Because of the nice weather, an educator went in to get water for the water table outside, the children

loved playing in the water! Observed that educators brought out all the children's water bottles, and that they were all labelled with their names.

Operator informed me that there is some new play material/structures being built for the outside play space. Should an item require protective surfacing, please refer to section 9.3.2 of the Operator's Manual to ensure compliance. Please ensure to speak with your Quality Assurance Monitor to see if the changes will require a Change in Service form or inspection.

Facility promotes a bright and welcoming environment. All play material are arranged on low (at children's level) and open shelves so that the children can easily have access what they want to play with.

Educators were observed sitting down at the lunch table with the children. They were also observed actively engaging in conversation with the children, creating a natural home-like environment.

Observed positive child guidance practices such as offering choices and assisting children in decision-making and using gentle reminders when needed.

There are several ceiling tiles that have what appear to be water stains on them (some by the kitchen, some by the vent outside of the three-year-old room, and some in the 4-year-old room). Please ensure to have them replaced as soon as possible for safety purposes.
