## **General Comments**

## Monitoring inspection performed.

Centre is well operated and there is always enough staff on site to meet staff child ratios which increases the quality of the service offered. This allows time for educators to plan programming and documentation of children's learning and work on Professional Learning opportunities. The operator indicated there are barriers for educators to sign up for in person training and virtual sessions, so the operator was pleased to learn she was approved by the district to offer a 6 1/2-hour session for the educators employed at her centre. Staff will be on target to meet the 10 hours of training prior to the license expiring in April 2024. There is evidence of programming posted outside the classrooms and inside which links to the curriculum goals. All educators continue to store programming stories and they are available for children to look at and reminisce. Licensing observed documentation in one of the new planning books that reads "celebrating being 4 years old and to a great year." The books are neatly organized and made to feel special and educator document activities and link to the curriculum goals.

Upon arrival children were observed in outdoor play. All children were observed going outdoors this AM. Children were observed playing in the outdoor kitchen centre, blocks and the monkey climber. The stationary equipment is in good condition and surrounded by protective surfacing. Educators take the cue from children when deciding to come indoors. There is a brisk cold wind this AM and some children wanted to go back inside and a few children were getting tired and began crying, so everyone got ready and moved inside. Positive child guidance was observed '- the educators were observed singing a song while walking inside to calm the children. Educators were also observed encouraging children to join them when practicing songs

calm the children. Educators were also observed encouraging children to join them when practicing songs "jingle bells, twinkle twinkle little star, the robot song. The young 2's are learning the words to the songs, so they mimic educators and repeat words and actions to the songs. Other educators acknowledge children's excitement by laughing, responding to children, and engaging in their play.

There is new flooring, new painted walls and new furniture in the two's classroom. Looks great!

The 3's classroom were watching their educator fill up the fish tank and place the fish back in the tank. The

educator explained the process of cleaning and talked about the purpose of the air filter. The children watched and asked questions and pointed to the fish.

All children were observed eating lunch and having a nap and soft soothing music was played. Children were observed waking up, toileting and washing hands.

Licensing staff reviewed administrative records - attendance, cleaning schedules, monthly fire drill record, outdoor check list, and incident reports and all records are in order. New staff information was also reviewed.
