General Comments

Licensing Staff arrived to introduce themselves as the facilities new Quality Assurance Monitor and perform a Monitoring Inspection. The center recently transitioned children to the next age group to prepare for September. The transition appears to be going smoothly, children were seen smiling, laughing and the Educators were engaged at the time of the visit.

In the 2's room the children were finishing up snack and were seen playing with cars and in the play kitchen area. In the 4's classroom the children were observed washing hands for snack time. The Educator sat at the table, eating snack with the group and was heard offering praise and using encouraging words. "You can do it!" "Great job!". As the children finished snack, the Educator sat with them and read "Be You" until everyone was finished snack and ready to go outside.

In the afterschool class, a few children had worked together to build a large railway track and train station. Others were seen playing dress up, making different designs with Perler Beads and playing in the Vet Clinic. After finishing snack, the afterschool group joined the other classes outside. All classes brought out a bookbag with their first aid kit, attendance and emergency records. All water bottles were brought outside.

The 3's and the 4's classroom is in the process of being re-painted. All rooms were organized and clean at the time of the visit. Childrens belongings are all labelled and cubby area is tidy. The rooms offer a variety of materials such as wooden blocks, doll houses, age-appropriate books and a play kitchen that has flyers, and empty containers such as shampoo bottles, different spice bottles and cereal boxes.
